- Following a proposal prepared by PJ Library coordinator Suzan Antin, we have received a small grant from the Harold Grinspoon Foundation for purchase of shelving to display PJ Library books.
 We are looking to place shelves in the vestibule and downstairs along the north wall.
- Enhancement of the security of our building is now underway thanks, in large part, to Al Kornhauser and his efforts in securing a grant and permits. Installation of additional security lights went forward on Dec. 12, and we'll put in security cameras soon. We found a viable, lower-cost solution for installation of covers on our stained-glass windows and are now interacting with the Town of Blacksburg and the Virginia Department of Emergency Management for permission to go ahead with the altered plans.
