PJ author Madelyn Rosenberg, who is the daughter of BJCC member Linda Deemer, will be here to kick off the celebration with a book talk at 11:00 AM in the sanctuary. Please gather at 10:45 AM so that she can start on time.

After Madelyn's book talk, we will go downstairs for brief remarks, refreshments, and crafts. We hope that you will take time to explore our wonderful collection of books and games and find something interesting to take home.

Our collection includes multiple books which have won the Sydney Taylor Award, given by the Association of Jewish Libraries to outstanding books for children and teens that authentically portray the Jewish experience. We also have Caldecott Medal winners. The Caldecott Medal is given to the most distinguished American picture book for children and is awarded by the American Library Association. Authors in our collection include Jane Yolen, Patricia Polacco, Maurice Sendak, Jan Brett, Leslie Kimmelman, Madelyn Rosenberg, Eric Kimmel, David Wisniewski, Chris van Allsburg, Sydney Taylor, and Isaac Bashevis Singer.
